# **Snowman Ornament & Decoration**

With two options, this pattern will help you create a small Snowman Ornament for your tree or a larger Snowman Decoration for a shelf or window .

I've included instructions for hats (2 sizes) and scarf (1 size)

I use 2 circular needles because I do a LOT of manipulation to the cord when I get to the top of the *body* and *head* of the snowman. Magic Loop would have that same flexibility.

## **Materials:**

Yarn: Snowman: Natural, Deluxe Worsted 100% Wool; 220yd, 100gm

Scarves: I used sock yarn for some, DK weight and even worsted

*Hats*: Olive and Mustard, Valley Yarn, Huntington; Sock; 218yd, 50gm

Sidewalk, Spud & Chloë, Fine; Fingering; 248yd, 65gm

Needles: Snowman, US 3 (3mm)

Hats: For Snowman, Scarves & Hats

Foam balls for Snowman body

Large Snowman Decoration: 3" & 2.5" Small Snowman Ornament: 2.5" & 2"

Felt scraps for buttons (black)

Doll Hat (optional)

## Abbreviations:

CO – Cast On with Disappearing Loop Cast On (Here is a good tutorial from djinnj)

k - Knit (used as, k3 - knit 3 stitches)

p – Purl

m1 - Make 1 stitch using the backwards loop cast on method



# **Large Snowman Decoration - Body Section:**

CO 8 stitches and divide between needles Join and knit 1 round \*

Round 1: (k1, m1) 8 times – 16 stitches Round 2: knit all stitches (all even rows) Round 3: (k2, m1) 8 times – 24 stitches Round 5: (k3, m1) 8 times – 32 stitches Round 7: (k4, m1) 8 times – 40 stitches Round 9: (k5, m1) 8 times – 48 stitches Round 11: (k6, m1) 8 times – 56 stitches

Rounds 12-24 knit all stitches

Round 25: (k5, k2tog) 8 times – 48 stitches Round 26: knit all stitches (all even rows) Round 27: (k4, k2tog) 8 times – 40 stitches Round 29: (k3, k2tog) 8 times – 32 stitches Round 31: (k2, k2tog) 8 times – 24 stitches

(Fit the 3" ball into the Snowman now!!)

Round 33: (k1, k2tog) 8 times – 16 stitches

Rounds 34-36: knit all stitches (his neck)

## **Large Snowman Decoration - Head Section**

Round 37: (k2, m1) 8 times – 24 stitches Round 38: knit all stitches (all even rows) Round 39: (k3, m1) 8 times – 32 stitches Round 41: (k4, m1) 8 times – 40 stitches Round 43: (k5, m1) 8 times – 48 stitches

Rounds 44-56: knit all stitches

Round 57: (k4, k2tog) 8 times – 40 stitches Round 59: (k3, k2tog) 8 times – 32 stitches Round 61: knit all stitches (all even rows) Round 63: (k2, k2tog) 8 times – 24 stitches

(Fit the 2.5" ball into the Snowman now!!)

Round 65: (k1, k2tog) 8 times – 16 stitches Round 67: k2tog 8 times – 8 stitches \*\*

Snip the end and thread it through the 8 remaining stitches. Pull snuggly but not overly tightly.

Weave in all ends.

## **Small Snowman Ornament - Body Section:**

CO 8 stitches and divide between needles Join and knit 1 round \*

Round 1: (k1, m1) 8 times – 16 stitches Round 2: knit all stitches (all even rows) Round 3: (k2, m1) 8 times – 24 stitches Round 5: (k3, m1) 8 times – 32 stitches Round 7: (k4, m1) 8 times – 40 stitches Round 9: (k5, m1) 8 times – 48 stitches

Rounds 10-22 knit all stitches

Round 23: (k4, k2tog) 8 times – 40 stitches Round 24: knit all stitches (all even rows) Round 25: (k3, k2tog) 8 times – 32 stitches Round 27: (k2, k2tog) 8 times – 24 stitches

(Fit the 2.5" ball into the Snowman now!!)

Round 29: (k1, k2tog) 8 times – 16 stitches

Rounds 30-32: knit all stitches (his neck)



## **Small Snowman Ornament - Head Section**

Round 33: (k2, m1) 8 times – 24 stitches Round 34: knit all stitches (all even rows) Round 35: (k3, m1) 8 times – 32 stitches Round 37: (k4, m1) 8 times – 40 stitches

Rounds 38-46: knit all stitches

Round 47: (k3, k2tog) 8 times – 32 stitches Round 48: knit all stitches (all even rows) Round 49: (k2, k2tog) 8 times – 24 stitches

(Fit the 2" ball into the Snowman now!!)

Round 51: (k1, k2tog) 8 times – 16 stitches Round 53: k2tog 8 times – 8 stitches

Snip the end and thread it through the 8 remaining stitches. Pull snuggly but not overly tightly.

Weave in all ends.

#### Hat

Numbers are listed as: small (large)

Cast on 40 (60) stitches and join in the round

Rounds 1-6: \* k1, p1; repeat from \* to end of round 6.

Rounds 7-20 (24): knit.

*Decrease Rounds* – Decreasing 4 (8) stitches evenly on each:

Round 21 (25): \* [k8, k2tog]; repeat from \* to end of round. 36 (54) Stitches

Round 22 (26): knit, for all even rows

Round 23 (27): \* [k7, k2tog]; repeat from \* to end of round. 32 (48) Stitches

Round 25 (29): \* [k6, k2tog]; repeat from \* to end of round. 28 (42) stitches

Round 27 (31): \* [k5, k2tog]; repeat from \* to end of round. 24 (36) stitches

Round 29 (33): \* [k4, k2tog]; repeat from \* to end of round. 20 (30) stitches

Round 31 (35): \* [k3, k2tog]; repeat from \* to end of round. 16 (24) stitches

Round 33 (37): \* [k2, k2tog]; repeat from \* to end of round. 12 (18) stitches

Round 35 (39): \* [k1, k2tog]; repeat from \* to end of round. 8 (12) stitches

Round 37 (41): k2tog to end of round. 4 (6) stitches

Thread end through the remain stitches and inside the hat. Weave in the end and clip.

## Scarf

Cast on 45-65 stitches

\* knit to last stitch, s1 wyf

Repeat until scarf is as wide as you like Cast off



## **Techniques & Notes:**

For final stitch in binding off: 1) When you cut your yarn, leave enough to make the Ornament Hanger as you weave in the ends. Then 2) Follow Ysolda's technique for Avoiding Ears When Casting On and Off
